

Rochesterfest Information
FRIDAY, JUNE 25, 2010

- Band Room opens at 3:30PM to pick up uniforms. Please arrive at Mayo Field at 4:30 PM (Remember to eat before you come because you will not be eating until after 8:00 PM) **Please come dressed in bibs and band shoes.** Bring garment bag with uniform jacket. Be sure to check for gloves, shoes, and black socks and hat before you leave LHS.
- Provide your own rides to Mayo Field (Mayo Field is where the Honkers play and is located across from Mayo Civic Center). Set up “camp” by placing your garment bag, instrument cases, backpacks, change of clothes, etc all together. We will change into uniform jackets after warm-ups.
- Bring water bottles. (NO POP BEFORE PARADE BECAUSE POP DEHYDRATES) Begin to hydrate 2 days before the parade.
- Drink plenty of water and communicate to band parents if you are not feeling well.
- Warm-up nice and easy. We have a long parade and you need to pace yourself. Invite parents and fans to meet by judge’s stand (Roscoes on 4th Street) and cheer for our band.
- After parade we will meet at Mayo Field and hang up our uniforms neatly. **YOU** must hang up your own uniform bag (with hat inside garment bag and put away your plume.
- NO ONE leaves the area until instructions are given to dismiss.
- Please be a part of the group throughout the evening.
- Food (hotdogs/chips) will be provided by the Rochesterfest committee after the parade.
- **The LHS has always marched in the Rochesterfest parade. Thanks to all of you for being a part of a great tradition!** It is fun to hang out and watch awards. We will do this as a group.
- If students need to leave with parents before the end of awards, students/parents should check in with Mr. Krueger or Mr. Mangan personally. (This is a school policy when we are traveling to other events...we like students to begin right away to adopt this policy for student safety.)
- We will unload all percussion equipment and uniforms at LHS after the awards ceremony. **Everyone** should come to LHS to help unload and put away equipment
